CALL TO ORDER:

The Monthly Business Meeting of the West Shore Regional Police Department Commission was held at 510 Herman Ave, Lemoyne, PA and called to order at 5:34 p.m. by Chairman Gallo with the Commissioner Preble leading the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Motion:

Commissioner Stuart made a motion to approve the Minutes of the January 14, 2026 Monthly Business Meeting that were previously distributed, seconded by Commissioner Salkowski. The motion passed unanimously.

CHAIRPERSON’S REPORTS

Chairperson Gallo thanked the officers for their job and efforts during the snow emergency.

TREASURER’S REPORT:

Commissioner Preble reported balances of \$822,754.74 in the checking account, \$11,420.55 in the donation checking account and \$8,368.04 in the K9 donation account as of January 31, 2026. Commissioner Preble also reported a balance of \$61.36 in the Capital Reserve Fund and \$262,941.92 in the PLGIT Investment Account.

Motion:

Commissioner Preble made a motion to approve the January 2026 Treasurer’s Report and to submit it for audit, seconded by Commissioner Stuart. The motion passed unanimously.

January 2026 Calls for Service, Traffic, Criminal, and Ordinance Arrests, Incident Log by Offense

Snow Emergency – Chief Minium advised the Commission the snow emergency went well. There was a total of seven vehicles towed from Wormleysburg and thirteen from Lemoyne. The department went through the boroughs for six hours beforehand advising residents to move their vehicles.

End of Year Report – Chief Minium highlighted the 2025 annual report discussing calls for service for each borough and highlighting that the department is third in the county for calls of service. The full 2025 Annual Report can be found on the department’s website for the public to look at.
