CALL TO ORDER:

The Monthly Business Meeting of the West Shore Regional Police Department Commission was held at 510 Herman Ave, Lemoyne, PA and called to order at 5:37 p.m. by Chairman Gallo with the Commissioner Preble leading the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Motion:

Commissioner Salkowski made a motion to approve the Minutes of the February 11, 2026, Monthly Business Meeting that were previously distributed, seconded by Commissioner Preble. The motion passed unanimously.

CHAIRPERSON'S REPORTS

Chairperson Gallo took a moment to recognize the passing of a former officer, Russell Wheller. He passed March 6th, 2026, at the age of 89. He served with the West Shore

Regional Police Department for 34 years before retiring in 1998. Chairperson Gallo asked for a moment of silence.

TREASURER’S REPORT:

Commissioner Preble reported balances of \$598,243.08 in the checking account, \$8,537.43 in the donation checking account and \$8,368.68 in the K9 donation account as of February 28, 2026. Commissioner Preble also reported a balance of \$61.53 in the Capital Reserve Fund and \$323,773.03 in the PLGIT Investment Account.

Motion:

Commissioner Preble made a motion to approve the February 2026 Treasurer’s Report and to submit it for audit, seconded by Commissioner Griva. The motion passed unanimously.

CHIEF MINIUM'S REPORT:

Chief Minium submitted the following reports to the Commission:

February 2026 Calls for Service, Traffic, Criminal, and Ordinance Arrests, Incident Log by Offense

Awards – Chief Minium advised that he put communication out to the department regarding an award dinner. He mentioned there were multiple awards to be given to officers for calls of service during 2025. Chief Minium asked the commission if they would like to have an award dinner or ceremony. Chief Minium suggested giving out awards at National night out to show the public the recognition. Commissioner Griva asked what the officers would like, which Officer Kreitz said he thinks national night out would be a great way to show the public how the officers are appreciated for the job they do.

Department Meeting – Chief Minium advised that the department meeting will be held March 31st between the times 12:00pm - 4:00pm. The Chief welcomed the commission to come and advised the department will cater lunch.

Libra – Chief Minium gave an update on the concerns with K9 Libra. He stated that they reached out to trainers to see who would be willing to retrain Libra, but nobody agreed to training Libra due to them not being Libras original trainer. Chief Minium read an email that was sent from the original trainer expressing concerns with her behavior, with aggression, and weight for Libra. Chief expressed the program with Libra is not working out and he thinks its best to end the program. Chairperson Gallo asked to continue conversation regarding the matter in executive session.

ASSISTANT CHIEF FRIEL'S REPORT:

SERGEANT CONROY'S K9 REPORT:

Sergeant Conroy reported that the K9 Unit had 0 K-9 usages inside our jurisdictions, 5 K-9 usages to assist outside agencies, 19 training days, 2 PR assignment, 12 K-9-foot patrol details, 1 Other K-9, and K9 Libra 5 Therapy calls during the month of February.

Officer Kreitz advised the Commission that there will be a softball and pickleball tournament be put together to raise money for the K9 donation account. Officer Kreitz also gave an update to the Commission regarding some issues with Raff and how he is correcting the behavior with extra training.

OLD BUSINESS:

Chief Minium added that he and Assistant Chief Friel attended the Central Chief's meeting this week. One of the guest speakers was from ICE and they discussed the incentives for having an officer trained to make ICE arrests. Chief wanted to advise and remind the Commissioners they would be the ones to implement the program if they see it fit within the department.

Assistant Chief Friel advised that the new radio system is up and running. The department had only one installation issue in the wiring in the vehicles which B. Moyer Radio will be fixing.
