- Prescription and over-the-counter solid medications (i.e. tablets and capsules)
- Liquid medications, inhalers, patches, creams, ointments, nasal sprays
- Pet medications
- **NEW!** Vaping devices, cartridges, pods and e-liquids (please remove batteries)

Products NOT Accepted

- Injectables and needles
- Illicit substances

Why We Are Collecting

- Over 50% of people who abuse prescription pain relievers get them from friends or relatives.
- Prescription and over-the-counter drugs are the most commonly misused substances by Americans age 14 and older, after marijuana and alcohol.
- When drugs are flushed down the toilet, filters may not remove all of the chemicals.
- Vaping is an emerging method of drug use and a public health threat to Bucks County youth.
