## AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

Your affiants, Chief Daniel J. Doyle and Sergeant Phillip D. Kulan #22 are Pennsylvania Act 120 Sworn Municipal Police Officers employed by the Tullytown Borough Police department in Bucks County, Pennsylvania. Chief Doyle has been duly sworn since 1997. Sgt. Kulan has been duly sworn since 2007.

On Tuesday, October 3, 2017, at approximately 1213 hours, Tullytown Police were dispatched to the Walmart located at 180 Levittown Parkway, Levittown, Bucks County, Pennsylvania for a retail theft in progress involving a black male, subsequently identified as the defendant, Christopher D. Kuhn, DOB 10/8/1989. According to the Walmart Asset Protection Officer Ronald Cromwell, (APO), Kuhn was observed placing a Vizio sound bar, valued at \$228 into his cart, and walking towards the store exit without attempting to pay for the item.

At the time, Kuhn had a male child with him, approximately two years of age, who was seated in the cart. Once Kuhn passed all points of sale without paying for the sound bar, the APO attempted to stop him. Kuhn told the APO "you can't hold me here" then removed the child from the cart and left the store. Witnesses observed Kuhn walk down the front of the store and into the parking lot of the Firestone Service Center, adjacent to the Walmart.

Witnesses observed Kuhn put the child into the back seat of a Gold SUV, but did not observe the defendant place the child into a child safety seat. Kuhn then placed his sweatshirt over the rear license plate of the SUV, before he got into the vehicle and drive off.

When Tullytown police arrived at the Walmart for the retail theft call, the officer was advised by the LPO that the male retail theft suspect had fled in a gold SUV, leaving the parking lot and travelling southbound on Route 13. Investigation revealed that the suspect was driving a gold in color, 2007 Jeep Wagon bearing NJ registration G77CXN. The responding officer then turned his vehicle around and exited the parking lot, heading southbound on Route 13 in time to observe that a three vehicle crash had just occurred at Route 13 and Exit 4 of the shopping center.

According to witnesses, the gold SUV was driving recklessly, travelling at a high rate of speed through a steady red light at the intersection of Route 13 (SB) and Exit 4 when the suspect vehicle was struck by another SUV entering the intersection. The SUV that struck the fleeing suspect vehicle had a steady green light before it entered the intersection. The vehicle that struck the suspect vehicle clearly had the right of way. The suspect vehicle then flipped and rolled, landing partially onto a third SUV at the intersection, before coming to rest.

After the crash, a witness observed the defendant get out of his SUV and walk over to and look at the child laying on the ground, before he fled on foot.

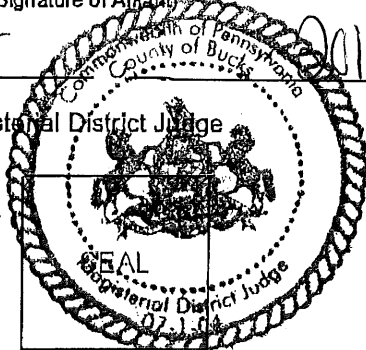

## AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE CONTINUATION

Upon arrival at the crash scene, police were directed towards a black male that had just fled the scene on foot. Police pursued the suspect and took the defendant into custody. Once police apprehended the defendant, they asked him where the baby was, and the defendant stated "back there" indicating the crash scene.

Investigation revealed that the child had been ejected from the defendant's SUV during the crash, and land in the roadway of southbound Route 13, next to the defendant's vehicle. A child safety seat was located in the back of the defendant's gold SUV.

Officer Gotz had arrived on-scene and found an unidentified, unresponsive male, approximately two years of age, laying in the roadway next to the defendant's vehicle. The child was unresponsive, and without a pulse. Officers attempted to revive the child by giving him CPR, until medics arrived. The child was then transported to Lower Bucks Hospital where he was pronounced deceased.

A certified driver's abstract from the State of New Jersey for the defendant was obtained and indicated that Christopher Kuhn's license is suspended.

When the suspect was apprehended, he was placed into the back of a patrol car, where he was non-responsive and uncooperative to police questions regarding the incident or the identity of the child.
