On April 29th, Swatara Township hosted the 4th Annual Senior Resource Fair at the LCBC Church. Det. Seiler and Cpl. Pokrop coordinated the event which featured 108 registered vendors from in and around the Harrisburg area. Det. Moyer and Ofc. Tillman assisted during the fair. Supt. Stauffer, Lt. Shatto and Lt. Milsteen were also in attendance. There were over 500 people who attended the fair, which was open to the general public. The fair also featured a blood pressure station and drug drop off location.
