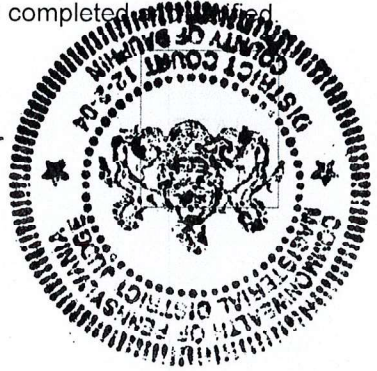

While being pursued by Police Officers, the defendant forced his way into 5E Hall Manor Harrisburg Pa, while holding a loaded pistol in his hand. While others fled the residence, the defendant grabbed a two year old female child, with initials N.R., and held her, inside the residence, as a hostage for several hours.

## AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

On May 30, 2023 at about 1330 hours Harrisburg Police Officer Jacobbi Harper, Dauphin County Parole Officer Cale Hoover and Dauphin County Parole Officer James Robbins witnessed Antonio Hammond, the defendant, trying to conceal a silver semiautomatic pistol while standing near the area of 41 row Hall Manor Harrisburg Pa. When they approached the defendant, the defendant fled on foot. The officers identified themselves and ordered the defendant to stop. During the pursuit, the defendant turned, pointed the pistol directly at Officer Cale Hoover and pulled the trigger. The defendant was about five yards away from Officer Cale Hoover when this occurred. The defendant discarded a book bag during the pursuit.

The defendant continued to flee while holding the pistol in his right hand. The defendant forced his way into 5 D Hall Manor Harrisburg Pa by entering the front door with the pistol still in his right hand. This apartment was occupied by the current resident, Wanda Colon, and her two small children. The defendant fled out the rear of 5 D Hall Manor and forced his way into 5 E Hall Manor Harrisburg Pa by entering the rear door. The defendant did this while continuing to brandish the pistol.

The defendant forced his way into 5 D Hall Manor while it was occupied by the resident, Michele Peters, and her two small children, by entering the rear door.

The defendant forced Michele Peters and a child out of the residence while he grabbed two year old N.R. and held her as a hostage. The defendant held N.R. to his chest with his left hand while holding the pistol in his right. Several officers repeatedly ordered and pleaded with the defendant to let the child go. The defendant refused.

The Dauphin County Crisis Response Team arrived on scene. A standoff ensued for several hours. Members of the team established communication with the defendant via cell phone. Team members had the defendant's family members and close family friends talk to him, trying to get him to release N.R.. The defendant refused and barricaded himself in the residence while continuing to hold N.R. to his chest.

At about 1615 hours the Dauphin County Crisis Team members entered the rear of 5 E Hall Manor to rescue N.R.. While team members entered the residence, by the rear door, they found the defendant holding N.R. to his chest with the pistol still his other hand. The lead team member, saw the pistol in the defendant's hand and got on top of the defendant in an attempt to control the pistol. The defendant wrestled for control of the pistol. Due to the defendant potentially shooting N.R. and or team members, the lead team member shot the defendant while they were struggling for the pistol. The defendant was shot in the facial area.

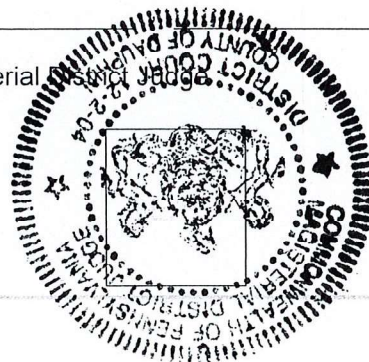



**AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE CONTINUATION**

After the gunshot, another team member grabbed N.R. from the defendant and carried N.R. to safety. The defendant's pistol was removed from his hand. The pistol is a loaded 9mm semiautomatic with serial number PB0143878. Medical aid was summoned. The defendant was transported to a local hospital via ambulance.

During the standoff and after the event, the following was learned: The defendant had a warrant for his arrest issued by Pa State Probation and Parole for absconding. The defendant plead guilty to felony Aggravated Assault he committed on June 11, 2014. The defendant did not possess a license to carry a firearm due to the felony conviction. The pistol the defendant possesses was reported stolen in 2018 by the owner, Benjamin Weimer. A book bag the defendant discarded during the foot pursuit contained a brown powder believed to be heroin, half inch by half inch glassine baggies and hypodermic needles.
