DESCRIPTION OF VIOLATION

An anonymous Silent Witness report was submitted alerting the College to potential concerns related to a baseball team trip to Myrtle Beach, South Carolina. Upon notification, the College conducted a thorough investigation over the following several weeks. Interim measures were taken to remove involved staff and students from the campus community pending investigation outcomes.

INVESTIGATIVE FINDINGS/SANCTIONS

Concerns identified included verbal and physical altercations between multiple players on 3 separate occasions (2 on the trip in question, and 1 from an earlier semester). One concern that surfaced through the investigation was identified as having occurred during Fall 2025. This event was physical in nature. The other two events occurring in Myrtle Beach were verbal and physical in nature. Intimidation of younger players by older players was discovered. As a result, multiple students were suspended and staffing changes were made.
