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FOUR MEN ARRAIGNED ON INDICTMENT CHARGING MURDER RELATING TO A SHOOTING NEAR STITZEL FIELD IN POUGHKEEPSIE

Dutchess County District Attorney Anthony Parisi announces today that Peter Green, 31, Shanardo Green, 29, Paul Green, 35, and Tyrese Hall, 21 were arraigned this week on an Indictment returned by a Dutchess County Grand Jury charging them each with one count of Murder in the Second Degree, a Class A-1 Felony.

District Attorney Anthony Parisi stated, “The allegations contained in this indictment describe an extraordinary level of violence and a complete disregard for human life and public safety. According to the investigation, this attack unfolded in a public area where community members had gathered for a soccer game, placing countless innocent people at risk. No one should have to fear that an afternoon at a neighborhood park could become the scene of deadly violence.”

The incident charged in the Indictment occurred on the evening of April 19, 2026, in the City of Poughkeepsie, in the area of Stitzel Field. It is alleged that the defendants aiding, abetting, and acting in concert with each other, with intent to cause the death of Carl Chambers, caused the death of Carl Chambers. It is alleged that Peter Green and Tyrese Hall drove a Mitsubishi to the area Stitzel Field where a soccer game was being played and Paul Green and Shanardo Green followed behind them in a Nissan. Peter Green and Tyrese Hall allegedly exited their vehicle near Mr. Chambers and an altercation ensued. Peter Green then allegedly stabbed Mr. Chambers on the right side of his torso. It is further alleged that Shanardo Green exited Paul Green’s Nissan carrying an AR style rifle that he then fired at Mr. Chambers, striking him multiple times. It is alleged that Tyrese Hall then stood over Mr. Chambers and shot him again with a pistol. Allegedly, Paul Green then drove all of the defendants from the scene in the Nissan. Mr. Chambers died as a result of the defendants’ actions.

The case was investigated by the City of Poughkeepsie Police and is being prosecuted by Deputy Chief Assistant District Attorney Andrea Long and Unit Chief Brittney Kessel. Judge Karen Edelman-Reyes presided over the cases. Peter Green, Shanardo Green and Tyrese Hall were all remanded without bail. Bail was set at \$1million cash, \$3 million bond and \$7.5 million partially secured bond for Paul Green. The next court date is scheduled for October 16, 2026 for all.

As with any criminal case, the charges described above are merely accusations, and all those mentioned are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.

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
