AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Your affiant, Detective John Bonargo, Badge #159, of the Warminster Police Department, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, has been duly sworn/appointed/employed as a police officer in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania since 1992. Your affiant is certified as a police officer in Pennsylvania. Your affiant is authorized to conduct criminal investigations and make arrests in all criminal cases.

The facts set forth in this affidavit as based upon your affiant's personal knowledge; knowledge obtained from other individuals/entities during his participation in this investigation, including other law enforcement officers; review of documents and records related to this investigation; communications with others who have personal knowledge of the events and circumstances described herein; as well as information gained through his training and experience.

The circumstances of this matter are that on or about May 28, 2024, at approximately 2:06pm members of the Warminster police department responded to a report of theft and robbery of an orange Dodge TRX pickup truck from 271 East County Line Road, Warminster, Pennsylvania., The CountyLine Shopping Center.

Your affiant responded and spoke with the victim, Evelyn Kenndy, the owner of the Bronzing and Sugaring Studio, located at 271 East Countyline Road, Warminster. Evelyn said that when she arrived at work at approximately 10:30am she noticed and black Didge Challenger. Evelyn was waiting for another customer and was sitting in a chair in the studio. Two males she described as wearing black face masks and dressed in black came into the studio.

The taller male she thought was Dominican looking, lifted his hoodie style shirt and displayed a handgun in his waist band. The male told her to give her the key to her truck. Evelyn got up and went to the counter where her keys were. She retrieved her keys and removed the truck key. The male took the key and the second male dressed similarly, took her personal cell phone. Both left the store. And got into her truck. Once they left Evelyn called 911. During the robbery Evelyn told the pair of males that she was single mother.

Evelyn related to your affiant she was afraid during the robbery.

Detective John Schlotter, a member of the Warminster police department, reviewed video from the studio. The video and audio show the males entering the studio, displaying the handgun, and demanding the truck key. It also showed the male with the gun holding onto the weapon while Evelyn is trying to comply with the demand for the key. The second male told her to give him her cell phone after the key. This second male then grabbed the cell phone from Evelyns' hand.

Your affiant and Sergeant Casey Byrne of the Warminster police department monitored that a police pursuit had occurred for victim's orange truck. We were then informed that members of the Bensalem police department. Had taken a person of interest into custody after being found in the area of a black Dodge Challenger. Officer Chris Baran, of the Bensalem police department, related that he located the vehicle near Brown and Eddington Roads in their township. A neighbor told him that a guy had run from the vehicle (black Dodge Challenger). Officer Baran located the defendant a short distance away. The defendant surrendered and told Officer Baran he does not have a gun.

Your affiant and Sergeant Byrne spoke with the defendant at the Bensalem police department. The defendant told your affiant and Sergeant Byrne that he had been picked up in the morning by "Money" in the black Dodge Challenger that Officer Baran located. In the vehicle were two other males, one named "Mere", and the other was unknown.

Money drove all four to a Chic-fil-a and following that drove the Countyline Shopping Center. The location of the victim and her truck. The defendant was given and black ski mask, that was recovered from his front left pocket by Officer Baran, and he was told he could make some money for being there. The defendant was told to put the ski mask on and to be quiet. The defendant knew they were going to steal the truck at that point. Prior to arriving at the shopping center, the defendant observed the male with the



gun load the weapon. He described the gun as BB-Gun, and it appeared to look like a Glock. The defendant watched as the two males go into studio and then exit. The two males drove in the orange (victim's) truck. The defendant and Money drove in the black Dodge Challenger and the truck followed them. The truck eventually left them and went in their own direction. Money and the defendant had an accident and left the scene. Money pulled the car over in Bensalem and told the Defendant to delete what was on his phone. Both the defendants did this and then Money got out of the car and left the area. The defendant then drove the car what he described as several blocks and pulled over. He ran from the car and when he saw a police car he gave up.

Based on the information provided in the affidavit, your affiants believe that the actions of the defendant Reynaldo Almanzar Rodriguez, an 18-year-old male from Philadelphia, along with 3 other males one named Money and one named Mere, were in violation of Pennsylvania Crimes Code, Title 18 SEC: 3702. Robbery of motor vehicle, 3701 Robbery and related offenses.
