

Thank You for your interest in the Lower Paxton Township Police Departments second annual **HIGH SCHOOL FORENSICS ACADEMY!** The 2018 LPPD HSFA will be held June 18-22, 2018. Meeting times are 0900-1500 hours each day. The HSFA is free to all accepted students. The HSFA is limited to 20 students. Eligible students must be in 9-12 grade as of the 2018-19 school year. Priority will be given to students who are Lower Paxton residents.

During the HSFA students will receive instruction on various techniques and theories used in the field of criminal forensics and criminology. Students will learn about fingerprints, blood splatter, entomology, glass shard examination, tool marks and identification of unknown substances among other things.

Students applying to the HSFA should possess a high level of maturity and have a genuine interest in the subject.

The meeting location for each day will vary and students/parents are responsible for transportation to and from the HSFA. Students accepted to attend the HSFA will be provided with an itinerary and directions, if needed. The locations of the HSFA will include LPPD and Dauphin County Vo-Tech Schools Crime Lab. Students accepted to the HSFA should make every attempt to attend each days' instruction.

Lunches and drinks are the responsibility of the individual students. Students should plan on bringing a "brown bag" type lunch. The daily instruction will vary and "lunch time" will be fit into the instruction as the individual lessons allow.
