

**A PUBLIC MEETING  
YORK COUNTY REGIONAL POLICE COMMISSION  
MAY 20, 2026**

A public meeting of the York County Regional Police Commission was held on Wednesday, May 20, 2026, at the York County Regional Police Department, 33 Oak St., York, PA 17402.

Those present were Kathy Kerchner, Commissioner, David Naylor, Commissioner, Anne Gray, Commissioner, Robert Kessler, Commissioner, Paul Knepper, Commissioner, Stanley Saylor, Commissioner, Andrew Herrold, Commissioner, Darryl Albright, Commissioner, Timothy Damon, Chief of Police, Peter Ruth, Solicitor, and Angela Longnecker, Business Administrator.

Commissioner Kerchner called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

Pledge of Allegiance.

**Approval of Resolution 2026-8**

Chief Damon reviewed Resolution 2026-8. A motion to approve Resolution 2026-8 was made by Commissioner Saylor, seconded by Commissioner Kessler, motion carried.

Chief Damon presented Detective Longnecker with a retirement plaque and thanked him for his twenty-eight years of service.

Chief Damon presented a Letter of Commendation to Kevin Shoff, Jessy Hoover, and Jason Eickmeyer (not present) for their actions that saved a life on April 16, 2026. Kelly Henshaw from Senator Phillip-Hill's office also presented Kevin Shoff, Jessy Hoover and Jason Eickmeyer (not present) with a citation from the Senate.

Commissioner Kerchner thanked Detective Longnecker for his service. Commissioner Kerchner also thanked the civilians for helping people in our community.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

Commissioner Kerchner informed the public that due to the large number of people attending, and in accordance with the Commission's policy on public comment, they will need to be a taxpayer or resident in one of the participating municipalities to make a comment. Commissioner Kerchner asked for a motion to approve the expenses for April 1, 2026, through April 30, 2026, in the amount of \$ 1,330,920.59. A motion to approve the expenses was made by Commissioner Naylor, seconded by Commissioner Gray, motion carried.

#### **Approval of General Reserve Fund Expenses for April 1, 2026 through April 30, 2026 - \$39,048.00.**

Commissioner Kerchner asked for a motion to approve the expenses for the General Reserve Fund for April 1, 2026, through April 30, 2026, in the amount of \$39,048.00. A motion to approve the expenses was made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Saylor, motion carried.

### **SOLICITOR'S REPORT**

#### **Approval of SEK's estimate of Accounting Services**

Attorney Ruth asked for a motion to approve SEK's estimate of Accounting Services. A motion to approve SEK's estimate of Accounting Services was made by Commissioner Naylor, seconded by Commissioner Saylor, motion carried.

Attorney Ruth stated he has items for the executive session.

### **POLICE CHIEF'S REPORT**

Chief Damon informed the Commissioners that the Department had their accreditation assessment, and the Department was approved for re-assessment. This will be put on the consent agenda for the PLEAC meeting being held on June 2, 2026. Lt. Zimmerman read an excerpt from the Team Assessor Report.

Chief Damon reviewed grants and processes and what grants were being applied for. Samantha Dorm stated the Department is not just chasing money, we are working to partner with programs and build the programs and relationships before chasing the money. At this time there was discussion on partnering with the community, and how domestic calls are handled.

Chief Damon reviewed the activities for the month.

#### **Approval of transfer of money from Post Employment Healthcare Fund to the Capital Reserve Fund - \$ 47,000.00.**

**Approval of transfer of money from General Money Market to the Capital Reserve Fund - \$150,000.00.**

Commissioner Kerchner asked for a motion to approve the transfer of money from the Post Employment Healthcare Fund to the Capital Reserve Fund in the amount of \$47,000.00, and the transfer of money from the General Money Market to the Capital Reserve Fund in the amount of \$150,000.00. A motion to approve both transfers of \$47,000.00 and \$150,000.00 was made by Commissioner Naylor, seconded by Commissioner Saylor, motion carried.

Approval of transfer of money from General Money Market to the General Reserve Fund - \$221,700.00.

A motion to approve the transfer of \$221,700.00 from the General Money Market to the General Reserve Fund was made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Kessler, motion carried.

Chief Damon stated the online auction for the horse trailer was not successful, and did not meet the reserve.

Commissioner Gray had a few questions regarding the acronyms in the report for the automated messaging system for victims of crime, and who receives the messages on the automated messaging system for victims of crime.

**COMMISSIONER'S COMMENTS**

Commissioner Albright thanked Detective Longnecker for his service, thanked the citizens for getting involved and helping strangers, and congratulated the Department on the re-accreditation.

Commissioner Herrold had no comments.

Commissioner Saylor said ditto to Commissioner Albright's comments. He hopes everyone has a safe weekend.

Commissioner Kessler asked what a School Security position vs. a School Resource Officer is. Chief Damon stated that the School Security position is armed but not a sworn officer.

Commissioner Naylor congratulated Detective Longnecker for his years of service, and thanked the Department for the re-accreditation, outstanding job.

Commissioner Kerchner said ditto to all the thank you's. Commissioner Kerchner stated that all meetings are held on the third Wednesday of each month. All meetings are advertised at the beginning of the year. Chief Damon will add the meeting dates and place on the Department website under Police Commission. At this time there was discussion on the recording of the meetings and upgrading of recording equipment.

Commissioner Gray wished everyone a Happy Memorial Day weekend. We recognize and honor those that have served. Commissioner Gray received a comment regarding training for the 287(g) MOU, and she wanted confirmation that the training received was not for tactics and procedures. Chief Damon confirmed the training was not for tactics.

Commissioner Kerchner made a motion to recess to executive session at 7:35 pm.

The Commission reconvened at 8:11pm.

Commissioner Kerchner asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Commissioner Naylor at 8:11pm, seconded by Commissioner Saylor, motion carried.
