**PROCLAMATION BY THE MAYOR OF HIGHSPIRE**

**STATE OF DISASTER EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, conditions in the Borough of Highspire, as a result of heavy rain both locally and throughout Central Pennsylvania as the result of a tropical depression, the remnants of Hurricane Ida, which caused property damage, dangerous road, health and weather conditions, all or which have created an emergency in which there is a clear and present danger to life or property, and it is necessary to prohibit certain conduct in order to preserve the public peace within the Borough.


**Now Therefore**, by the authority vested in me by the Borough Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Article X, Section 1006, I hereby declare a **State of Disaster / Weather Emergency** within the Borough of Highspire, and proclaim as follows:

1. For the duration of this emergency, in order to safeguard the general welfare and permit free travel of authorized and emergency vehicles for flood operations to proceed without unnecessary hindrance, all persons are hereby ordered and directed to remove all vehicles parked within all designated Emergency evacuation routes. All parking along emergency evacuation routes shall be prohibited. All persons are further ordered and directed not to operate motor vehicles in the Borough of Highspire, except for essential travel or to preserve health and safety.
2. For the duration of the emergency hereby declared, all persons are hereby ordered to take precautionary measures. This includes voluntary evacuations of all persons within all designated weather emergency areas as necessary.
3. For the duration of the emergency hereby declared, all persons are hereby ordered and directed to obey all orders and directives of Borough police officers, State police officers, and all other duly constituted peace officers, regarding routes for vehicle and pedestrian traffic.
4. This state of emergency hereby declared and this Proclamation shall remain in effect for a period of seven (7) days, and thereafter if extended pursuant to the law.
