AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

Probable Cause belief is based upon the following facts and circumstances:

Your Affiant Detective William J. Davis #2425 MPO# 27171B of the Bristol Borough Police Department in Bucks County Pennsylvania. In accordance with Pennsylvania Municipal Police Jurisdiction Act, your affiant has been employed as a sworn police officer by the Bristol Borough Police Department since June of 1998. Detective William Davis #2425 MPO#27171B has a total of 22 years of Law Enforcement experience. Your Affiant is having been assigned to Criminal investigations since 2015 Investigating such crimes as Criminal Homicide, Rape, Robberies, Aggravated Assault Etc. Your affiant also has been assigned to work Patrol, Narcotics investigations, Forensic Evidence collection, and is on the Bucks County SWAT TEAM South.

Your Affiant, Detective Timothy Perkins, Badge #9921 of the Bucks County District Attorney's Office, (ORI# 0094800), Bucks County, PA., in accordance with certification from the Pennsylvania Municipal Police Jurisdiction Act, has been duly sworn, appointed, employed as a Police Officer in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania since 1994. As such, your Affiant is authorized to conduct criminal investigations and make arrests in all criminal cases. Your Affiant is certified as a Police Officer in Pennsylvania by the Pennsylvania Municipal Police Officers Education and Training Commission.

Your Affiant, Detective Eric Landamia, Badge #9924, of the Bucks County District Attorney's Office, Bucks County, PA, has been duly sworn/appointed/employed as a police officer in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania since 2001. Your Affiant is certified as a Police Officer in Pennsylvania. Your Affiant is authorized to conduct criminal investigations and make arrests in all criminal cases.

The facts set forth in this affidavit are based upon your Affiants' personal knowledge; knowledge obtained from other individuals/entities during our participation in this investigation, including other law enforcement personnel; review of documents and records related to this investigation; communications with others who have personal knowledge of the events and circumstances described herein; as well as information gained through our training and experience.

Because this affidavit is being submitted for the limited purpose of establishing probable cause, your Affiants have not included every aspect, fact, or detail of this investigation.

SYNOPSIS

On May 30, 2023, Sammar Khan killed her husband, Faisal Iqbal (Indian male, 39 years of age) via shooting Iqbal multiple times. This incident took place at the Bristol Borough Wharf, 1 Mill Street, Bristol Borough, Bucks County, PA 19007.

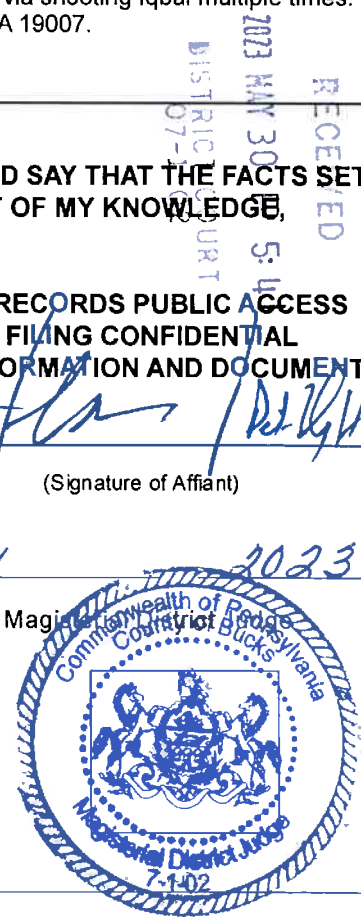

AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE CONTINUATION

Multiple witnesses were in the immediate area of the shooting, some of which witnessed Khan fire multiple gunshots at and/or into Iqbal, the final of which was directed at Iqbal's head as he lied on the ground.

This homicide occurred at a public park in the mid-morning hours of a weekday. The park area was occupied by multiple individuals at the time of the shooting.

Khan was spoken to by law enforcement shortly after the murder. Khan stated that the pair were at the park to discuss their relationship. Khan said the meeting did not go well and that she killed Iqbal.

Emergency Medical Services (EMS) personnel (Bucks County Rescue Squad) responded to the scene and subsequently determined Faisal Iqbal to be deceased.

INVESTIGATIVE SUMMARY:

On May 30, 2023 at 10:53am, the Bristol Borough Police Department responded to Bristol Borough Wharf, 1 Mill Street, Bristol Borough, Bucks County, PA 19007 for the report of a shooting. Upon arrival, a female, later identified as Sammar Khan, D.O.B. 4/02/1983, was found at the scene. Responding officers initially observed blood on the clothing of Sammar Khan.

Upon their entry to the scene, responding law enforcement personnel observed Faisal Iqbal, D.O.B. 6/08/1984 lying in a grassy area southeast of the parking lot. Iqbal had visible gunshot wounds to the torso and head. A Smith & Wesson M&P Shield 9mm firearm was found in the area, with blood on the slide.

Your Affiants spoke with several of the witnesses who were present in the park at the time of the murder. Their accounts are as follows:

Sammar Khan and Faisal Iqbal were talking in the area of the coastline. Khan was observed to be speaking loudly in another language. A pop sound was heard, at which time Iqbal, who had been seated on the coastline, brushed at himself as if he was brushing something off. Iqbal stood up and began to wrestle with Khan, at which time additional gunshots were heard.

Iqbal and Khan subsequently walked up from the coastline, from the water towards the parking lot area, where Iqbal told at least one witness to call 911. Khan shot Iqbal two (2) times, resulting in Iqbal collapsing in a grassy area between the water and the parking lot. Khan approached Iqbal while he was on the ground, raised a firearm at Iqbal with one hand, and shot him twice in the area of the torso. Khan then moved the gun to the area of Iqbal's head and fired an additional shot.

Emergency Medical Services (EMS) personnel (Bucks County Rescue Squad) responded to the scene and subsequently determined Faisal Iqbal to be deceased.

Affiant Landamia and Bristol Borough Police Officer Elifa Soto interviewed a male, whose identity is known to law enforcement, who reported to be Sammar Khan's boyfriend. This subject advised that he had been dating Khan for over one (1) year. At 10:53am this morning, this subject reported receiving a phone call from Khan, during which she stated she had killed Faisal and needed the male to pick up her son from the wharf. This subject knew Iqbal and Khan to have been in a previous relationship which had become tumultuous.

SUMMATION

Based on the above facts, your Affiant respectfully requests a warrant of arrest be issued for Sammar Khan for the following violations of the Pennsylvania Crimes Code:

1. Criminal Homicide Pa.C.S. 18 §2501
2. Murder of the First Degree Pa.C.S. 18 §2502
3. Possessing Instruments of Crime Pa.C.S. 18 §907
4. Recklessly Endangering Another Person Pa.C.S. 18 §2705

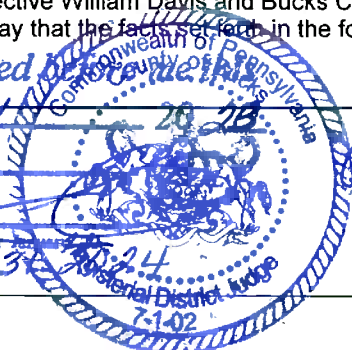
