The Northern Lancaster County Regional Police Commission met on a regularly scheduled meeting date of June 12, 2014, at the Clay Township Municipal Office, 870 Durlach Road, Stevens, Pennsylvania, at a time and place duly established to hold such a meeting, and advertised and posted in accordance with the Sunshine Law.
